Submit: 1 Jello mold or cake or 6-10 granola bars/cupcakes per category.

Entry deadline May 1st. No Registrations accepted the day of the contest.

Copy of ingredients to be included with entry (will not be shared).

Drop-off desserts between 11 AM-2 PM at the Duggan Community Center.

Judging to begin at 3:30ish.
