If Monticello schools are closed for a holiday or break, we are closed. Cancellations are posted on Facebook and may also be posted on the outside door of the Duggan Community Center. Also, if Monticello cancels after-school activities due to weather, most likely our programs are canceled as well.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR PROGRAMS USING THE GYM – during the winter weather and due to the use of heavy salt and sand in the parking lot, all participants in programs that occur in the gym **must bring their sneakers** instead of wearing them. **These sneakers should be free of salt, sand, and mud as these elements harm the gym floor.** The gym floor has not been resurfaced since summer 2009 and is easily damaged. If the floor becomes too damaged, we will not be able to use it for our programs.

Fitness Programs – held in the Duggan gym

Kick-it Off exercise class: Mike McCauley combines cardio moves with targeted exercises for the “problem areas” set to a rocking beat. Open to men and women. Wear comfortable clothes and bring sneakers. Participants are encouraged to do what you can, as long as you are moving. *We also offer modified Kick-it Off exercises for those who prefer to exercise sitting down in a chair.*
Special January discount: Free classes for all – youth and adults.

Tae Kwon Do classes: Tuesdays at 6:30 PM (beginner class) and 7:30 PM (intermediate). Sensei Mike McCauley. Cost is \$5 per class. **Youth must be at in 2nd grade.** Open to youth and adults. *Try it the first time for free.*

Walk the Halls – participants are encouraged to walk the hallway of Duggan School. Bring your own music or a friend to talk to. Enter by the gym and sign in at the table. Bring a sweater or sweatshirt as the halls do not have heat. **Tuesdays from 6:30 to 7:30 PM.**

At stop sign turn right onto Lackawaxen Scenic Dr.

At next stop sign turn right onto PA 590.

Turn right after crossing the first bridge onto Masthope Plank Rd.

At "T" turn left and go one mile to top of hill.

At 4-way stop, turn right onto Karl Hope Blvd. in Masthope Mountain Community.

Ski Big Bear is located at the end of Karl Hope Blvd.

Participants cover the cost of rentals and helmets. *For first time participants: if additional lessons are needed beyond the complimentary lesson, the TOB will cover the cost of up to 2 additional group lessons.*

Adults and non-resident youth: Pay the group rate costs for lift tickets, rentals and helmets. No program registration fee.
