### **Bethel Town Park and Pool is located at 636 Old White Lake**

**Turnpike Swan Lake.** Basketball court, pickleball court, nature trail, playground, pool, pavilion with restrooms, book garden, shaded picnic area and 2 charcoal grills. All patrons in the park are assumed by staff to have read all posted rules. Those not abiding by park and pool rules will be asked to leave.

**Noah's Buddy Benches have been placed in the park.** These homemade benches honor the memory of TOBY camper, Noah, who passed away in June 2018. What is a buddy bench? Everyone has experienced feeling a little lost and overwhelmed. Buddy benches are a simple and safe way for children to reach out to others around them. Making new friends and finding new activities to love was Noah's mantra. Please respect these special benches.

### **Town Park**

- The park is closed to the public from dusk to dawn and from July 8-August 16, M-F, until 1 PM.
- When accessing the playground when the main gate is closed, please do not park your vehicle in the roadway. There are no restrooms available when the main gate is closed.
- The garden is not open to the public. It is our youth camp's garden to give healthy options for snacks.
- We are an alcohol free, drug free and smoke free facility.
- No pets permitted (except certified service dogs)
- Rules are posted at the playground and on the grounds.
- Accessing the pool without a lifeguard on duty is trespassing and violators will be prosecuted.

**Pavilion Rentals** – the Town Park Pavilion is available for rent on weekends for family gatherings and birthday parties. Please contact the Parks and Recreation Department for available dates. \$90 rental fee for Town of Bethel

residents. \$130 for non-residents. Use of the pool is not included in rental fee, group rates are available for using the pool. Please call e-mail [bethelnyparksandrec@gmail.com](mailto:bethelnyparksandrec@gmail.com) for call 845-292-2843 on weekends for availability. **Must be 21 years of age to rent the pavilion.** No alcohol, inflatables, animals or large music venues are permitted. **Pool parties are available without the cost of renting the pavilion.**

**Town Pool** – expected opening date Saturday, June 29th. The pool is open to the public Monday-Fridays from 1 to 6 PM and Saturdays and Sundays from 11 AM to 7 PM, unless otherwise indicated (*July 4<sup>th</sup> open from 12 to 5 PM*). The season usually lasts until Labor Day but is subject to change due to lifeguard availability.

Daily or season passes are available for purchase at the pool. Town of Bethel residents must show proof of residency (physical address) to receive the Bethel resident rates. Patrons are expected to follow all pool and park rules which are posted at the pool and park. Our park is a smoke-free facility. Proper swim attire required. Please read rules before entering the pool area. No food inside the pool fence.

**TOBY Summer Camp** – All Day full-time is at capacity. Half day openings –limited availability. Registration will be held on Tuesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> from 9-10 AM at the Town Park or email [bethelnyparksandrec@gmail.com](mailto:bethelnyparksandrec@gmail.com) Cost: \$90 Bethel residents, \$120 Non-residents per child. Grades PreK-6.

**Morning Camp Dates and Times:** Camp begins **Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup>** and the **6-week** program ends **Friday, August 16<sup>th</sup>**. Hours are **9 AM**

**to 12: 30 PM.** *Early drop-off times (beginning at 7:30 AM) and late pick-up times (until 1:30 PM) are available for an additional fee.*

**All Day Camp Dates and Times:** Camp begins **Monday, July 8th**, and the **6-week** program ends **Friday, August 16<sup>th</sup>**. **Hours are 8:15 AM to 5:45 PM.** *Early drop-off times (beginning at 6:45 AM) and late pick-up times (until 6:10 PM) are available for an additional fee.*

## **Youth Programs**

**Pre-school Evening Swim Class:** \$35/child for four 45-minute sessions from **6:30-7:15 PM** on **Mondays and Wednesdays** at the Town Pool. Dates: **July 8<sup>th</sup>, July 10<sup>th</sup>, July 15<sup>th</sup>, July 17<sup>th</sup>**. (Rain dates: July 24<sup>th</sup> & July 29<sup>th</sup>) For pre-school aged children **ages 3-5 years old**. Introducing basic swim and water safety skills as well as becoming comfortable in the water are the goals of the program. Taught by certified ARC Water Safety Instructors. Limited enrollment.

**IPAP (Infant-Preschoolers Aquatics Program):** \$25/child for **three Saturday or Sunday morning** sessions of a **30-minute water adjustment class** for young children and a caregiver. The caregiver must be in the water with the child. The class teaches the caregiver how to safely work with the child on water skills. Held at the Bethel Town Pool. Open to children **6 months to 36 months old**. Limited enrollment. Taught by certified ARC Water Safety Instructors.

**Saturday sessions** – July 13<sup>th</sup>, July 20<sup>th</sup>, July 27<sup>th</sup> (rain date 8/3)

Ages 18 months to 36 months: 10 AM – 10:30 AM

Ages 6 months to 17 months: 10:30 AM – 11:00 AM

**Sunday sessions** – July 14<sup>th</sup>, July 21<sup>st</sup>, July 28<sup>th</sup> (rain date 8/4)

Ages 18 months to 36 months: 10 AM -10:30 AM

Ages 6 month to 17 months: 10:30-11:00 AM

**IPAP 2 (Toddler-Preschoolers Aquatics Program):** \$30/child for **four** weekday **August evenings** of a **30-minute water adjustment class** for young children and a caregiver. The caregiver must be in the water with the child. Held at the Bethel Town Park. Open to children 18 months to 4 years old. Limited enrollment. Taught by certified ARC Water Safety Instructors. **Monday and Thursday evenings** from **6:30-7:00 PM**.

**Registration for above programs:** Tuesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> from 6 to 6:30 PM at the Duggan School gym or with Park Attendant at Town Park

## **Fitness Programs**

**Yoga Flow: Move Like Animals:** four sessions on **Thursday evenings** in the **Duggan School gym** taught by Wayne Prisco, certified instructor. **Elementary-aged children** will be taught several **yoga poses** and will be introduced to *Drum Alive* – a **cardio drumming fitness routine**. **Course begins July 25<sup>th</sup>** and continues for 4 sessions ending August 15<sup>th</sup>.

**5:30-6:00 PM** for Grades **Pre-K to 2<sup>nd</sup>** (4 year old Pre-K child)

**6:05-6:35 PM** for Grades **3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>**

**Cost of the 4-session course is \$20/child** or pay a per class fee of \$8/child. Limited enrollment. Dress in comfortable clothes. Optional: yoga mat. Registration forms will be available at TOBY Camp or sign up at **registration** will be held on **July 16<sup>th</sup>** at **the Duggan gym** from **6 to 6:30 PM**. *TOBY Campers will be exposed to this new program the first week of camp.*

**Dance It Off:** have fun with friends as you move to the beat. Combines **cardio routines** with **targeted exercises** focusing on the arms, legs and stomach. Some of the routines from Kick-it Off will be used. Do what you can at your own pace. Wear comfortable clothes and sneakers. Class will be held on **Tuesday evenings** in the **Duggan gym** from **6:30-7:30 PM**. **Class begins July 2<sup>nd</sup>** *Class is free to youth ages 12 to 21 years old.* **Cost for adults: \$5/class.**

**Family Bus Trips**

- Proof of residency is required when registering for Town of Bethel residents. Proof must show physical residency (not a PO box).
- On the day of the trip a tip for the bus driver will be collected before boarding the bus in the AM. \$1 per youth or \$2/adult.
- Youth ages 18 to 21 years of age (proof required) may attend the trip unaccompanied by a parent or guardian.

**Dorney Park and Wildwater Kingdom Amusement Park – Thursday, August 1<sup>st</sup>.** Coach bus transportation to Allentown, PA for this fun 2-in-1 amusement park. Coach bus leaves Duggan School at 7 AM and Dorney Park at 7:30 PM. It is about a 2.5 hour bus ride. *No children under 3 may attend this trip.* **Cost of trip** (amusement park admission and coach bus seat):

Town of Bethel Youth (ages 3 -21)	\$30
Town of Bethel Adults (ages 22+)	\$50
Non-resident Youth (ages 3-21)	\$40
Non-resident Adults (ages 22+)	\$60

The costs above are subsidized. Gate cost of a regular admission (age 3 and over 48”) is \$60 and cost of a junior admission (age 3 and older under 48”) is \$42.

**Registration** will be held: **Tuesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> and July 9<sup>th</sup> 6-6:30 PM** in the **Duggan Gym** or **Saturday, July 6<sup>th</sup> from 11 AM to Noon** at the **Town Park**. Payment is due at registration. This is a non-refundable trip and is limited to 45 seats

**Radio City Christmas Spectacular – Saturday, November 9<sup>th</sup>.** Tickets in the **2<sup>nd</sup> Mezzanine level** for the **11 AM show**. Lunch on your own and time to shop after the show.
