Such resolution was duly approved by a majority of the qualified voters of said Fire District at a special election of said Fire District duly called, held and conducted on July 16, 2019.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A FLATBED WILDLAND VEHICLE, IN AND FOR THE WHITE LAKE FIRE DISTRICT IN THE TOWN OF BETHEL, SULLIVAN COUNTY, NEW YORK, AT A MAXIMUM ESTIMATED COST OF \$273,802 AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT EXCEEDING \$123,802 BONDS AND THE EXPENDITURE OF \$150,000 RESERVE FUND MONIES OF SAID FIRE DISTRICT TO PAY COSTS THEREOF.
