Customers receive \$30 for recycling energy-wasting second units. All they need to do is call to schedule a free pick up-and they'll receive a \$30 incentive payment. Appliance recycler JACO Environmental removes the appliances from participating customers' homes at no charge, then safely dismantles and recycles the energy-guzzling appliances in an environmentally responsible manner. The recycling program covers the removal of up to two refrigerators and/or stand-alone freezers units per household. Appliances must be in working order and have an inside volume of between 10 and 3-cubic feet.
