Big & Small Game Hunting

Big Game- Bowhunting season opened in the Southern Zone on October 1st. Firearms season for deer in the Southern Zone will open on November 15th - December 7th. Late Bow Dec. 8th – 16th.

Small Game Season opened on September 1, for cottontail rabbits, squirrels and turkey. Coyote hunting season opened across all of upstate New York on October 1, whereas seasons for other furbearing species (raccoon, fox, bobcat, and others) generally opens on October 25th

Youth Deer Hunt

New York's third annual [Youth Deer Hunt](#) will occur in upstate New York over the Columbus Day weekend (October 11-13). During this hunt, 14 and 15-year old junior hunters may take a deer of either sex with a firearm when accompanied by a licensed and experienced adult mentor.
