ON AN AUGUST afternoon in 1984, 15 years after the festival that rocked the nation and the world, Town of Bethel historian Bert Feldman, Leni Binder, Arthur Schubert, and Wayne Saward met at the corner of Hurd Road and West Shore Road to witness the laying of the Woodstock commemorative marker. The group had not obtained a permit and the installation was delayed, but the memory of "three days of peace and love" survived.
