

JULY 21, 1969

A meeting was held at the Town Hall, Town of Bethel, Sullivan County, N.Y. and those present were, Supervisor D.J. Amatucci, Justices- M. Sardonio and S. Liese, Councilman W.G. Prince and Mrs. Campion absent, Bldg. Inspector D. Clark, Zoning Board- Mr. Peters, Mr. Joyner, H. Reinshagen, P. Pauli, Planning Brd- Geo. Neuhaus, H. Bressler, A. Bernstein also delegation from Aquarian Music Festival.

Mr. Lawrence operations director for the Festival showed a map of areas involved where proposed activities will take place on Aug. 15, 16, 17. Shown were locations of food tents, stage and concession booths and stipulated that all structures will be taken down after the affair. He also stated that no alcoholic beverages will be sold on the premises. Camp area was shown and described. Water will be trucked in and area water supplies will be used and also portable sanitation facilities will be used to meet State standards.

Mr. Pomeroy spoke on securities and that all areas will be policed by qualified policemen in conjunction with State Police and Sheriff's office. He stated that 150,000 people were expected for the three day event. Also that parking areas will be set up with satellite parking areas available with bus service. Also, medical and first aid facilities will be set up with doctors and nurses available around the clock. Shows will start at 1 p.m. and run to approx. 2 a.m. each day.

Mr. Gross of Liberty stated that he was the legal representative for the Festival promoters and believed that they were complying with all rules and regulations.

The combined boards discussed that above and it was brought out that Town Attorney was consulted on the Boards stand and through the attorneys advice the Boards agreed that tentatively permission would be granted when the Music Festival group complied with all rules and regulations pertaining to health and sanitary rules, security, town and produced a bond in a suitable amount to cover the event.
